WINTER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME : 2019 - 2020

National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) has been constituted under an Act of Parliament, namely, the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 to lay down policies, principles and guidelines and frames effective and economical schemes for the State Legal Services Authorities to implement the Legal Services Programmes throughout the country. In every State, a State Legal Services Authority and in every High Court, a High Court Legal Services Committee has been constituted. District Legal Services Authorities and Taluk Legal Services Committees have been constituted in the Districts and most of the Taluks to give effect to the policies and directions of the NALSA and to provide free legal services to the people and conduct Lok Adalats in the State. Supreme Court Legal Services Committee has been constituted to administer and implement the legal services programme in so far as it relates to the Supreme Court of India.

NALSA has been conducting internship programme for the Law Students during summer and winter period of the year. The objective of the internship programme is that law interns should get a comprehensive idea of the working of the legal services institutions and the legal services programmes with the regional focus, as detailed in the attached Winter Internship Programme : 2019-2020 **(Annexure-A)**

NALSA invites online applications from the students studying in National Law Universities/Law Institutions and recognized Law Colleges of the country for its Winter Internship Programme : 2019-2020.

QUALIFICATION

Law Students pursuing their 5 years integrated Bachelor degree in law or pursuing the 3 years Bachelor degree in law and also the students of LL.M. can apply for the above-said internship.

PERIOD OF INTERNSHIP

The internship period will be about three weeks. The probable period of internship will be from December 2019 to mid- February 2020 and there will be three batches of students during the winter internship, as detailed below:-

- A. **Batch-I from 04.12.2019 to 26.12.2019-** On the completion of the period of internship with the District Legal Services Authority from 04.12.2019 to 13.12.2019 (14th and 15th December being holidays) and with Delhi State Legal Services Authority (Central Office, Patiala House Courts) New Delhi from 16.12.2019 to 20.12.2019 (21st and 22nd December being holidays), the student shall report to this Authority's Office at 12/11 Jam Nagar House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi -110 011 on 23.12.2019 at 10.30 AM. The student will remain with NALSA from 23.12.2019 to 26.12.2019 (25th December being holiday).

- B. **Batch-II from 07.01.2020 to 29.01.2020-** On the completion of the period of internship with the District Legal Services Authority from 07.01.2020 to 17.01.2020 (18th and 19th January 2020 being holidays) and with Delhi State Legal Services Authority (Central Office, Patiala House Courts) New Delhi from 20.01.2020 to 24.01.2020 (25th to 26th January 2020 being holidays), the student shall report to this Authority's Office at 12/11 Jam Nagar House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi -110 011 on 27.01.2020 at 10.30 AM. The students will remain at NALSA from 27.01.2020 to 29.01.2020.

- C. **Batch-III from 21.01.2020 to 12.02.2020**- On the completion of the period of internship with the District Legal Services Authority from 21.01.2020 to 31.01.2020 (1st and 2nd February, 2020 being holidays) and with Delhi State Legal Services Authority, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi from 03.02.2020 to 07.02.2020 (8th and 9th February 2020 being holidays), the student shall report to this Authority's Office at 12/11 Jam Nagar House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi -110 011 on 10.02.2020 at 10.30 AM. The student will remain at NALSA from 10.02.2020 to 12.02.2020.

HOW TO APPLY

Interested students can apply online through our website i.e. www.nalsa.gov.in from 10th October, 2019 (11 A.M onwards). The last date for receipt of application in this Authority is 30th October, 2019 (upto 5 P.M). Applications received after the due date or through e-mail/by post/by hand will not be entertained. Furnishing of recommendation letter duly signed by Dean /Principal/Head of the Faculty as per the prescribed proforma by NALSA is mandatory.

While applying online, the students are advised to indicate their choice of District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) after choosing the jurisdictional State Legal Services Authority (SLSA). They are also advised to indicate any one batch out of three batches. The final selection will be made by this Authority and, the selected students will be intimated through e-mail by 11th November, 2019. CONDITIONS APPLICABLE

1. NALSA reserves the right to select the number of interns and to revise the Scheme as and when it is found necessary.
2. No TA/DA or remuneration of whatever kind shall be paid by NALSA to the law intern. The law interns shall arrange themselves for their own stay or transport during the internship programme.

SELECTION OF INTERNS

Selection will be made on the basis of receipt of number of applications. Preference will be given to seniors in the Degree course(s).

AWARDING OF INTERSHIP CERTIFICATE

The certificate of internship shall be issued by NALSA to the intern on successful completion of the entire internship programme
